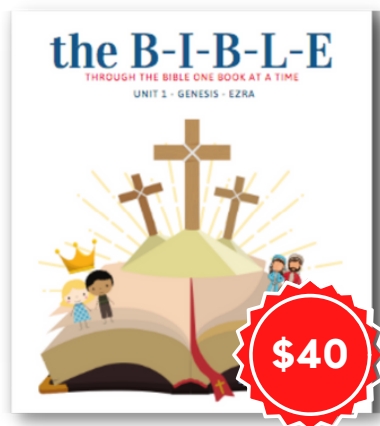

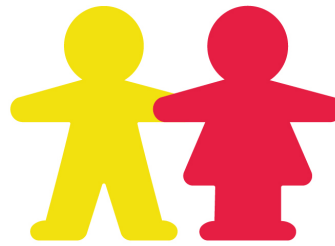

- Main Point: Jesus came back to life and now we can have new life with Him

April 24 - "The Whisper Challenge" - *Challenge Accepted*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: 1 Kings 19:9-18
- Main Point: Many people believe that God's voice is booming down from Heaven like a mighty wind, but often God speaks to us in a whisper.

MAY 2022



May 1 - "The Try Not to Laugh Challenge" - *Challenge Accepted*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Ecclesiastes 3
- Main Point: As humans, we cannot fathom the power of God. We sometimes don't understand God's big plan. So, it is important to be content (happy, joyful) while we wait for God's guidance.

May 8 - "The Seven Seconds Challenge" - *Challenge Accepted*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Joshua 6
- Main Point: The number 7 is a significant digit to God. He uses this number in the Bible to make his point.

May 15 - "The Blindfold Drawing Challenge" - *Challenge Accepted*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Mark 10:46-52
- Main Point: It is difficult to move forward when we don't know what will happen. But God wants us to have faith that he will guide us through life and reward us for that faith.

May 22 - "The What's in the Box Challenge" - *Challenge Accepted*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Acts 20
- Main Point: When we put our hands in a box and don't know what we'll pull out, it's sort of like living your life for God and not knowing what will happen to you.

May 29 - "The Brand Name Vs. Off-Brand Challenge" - *Challenge Accepted*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Deuteronomy 5
- Main Point: Buying "off-brand" products at the grocery store is a common practice when you want to save a few dollars. But there's no "off-brand" God. He is the real deal and there's no imitation.

JUNE 2022

June 5 - "The Pause Challenge" - *Challenge Accepted*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Esther 5
- Main Point: It is easy to want to do things in our own time. We want what we want when we want it. But God wants us to pause and listen to what he has to say before we act on our own will.

June 12 - "The Decision Challenge" - *Challenge Accepted*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Acts 16
- Main Point: We can choose to follow Jesus even when we are faced with challenges. God gives us instructions to follow to be saved and spend eternity with Him in Heaven.



June 19 - "Get on the Boat - Noah" - *Splash*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Genesis 6-9
- Main Point: All God's promises are yes in Jesus

June 26 - "Through the Water- Exodus" - *Splash*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Exodus 14-15
- Main Point: Jesus is the Only Way to God

JULY 2022

July 3 - "Dip in the Water - Naaman" - *Splash*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: 2 Kings 5
- Main Point: God heals people's hearts

July 10 - "Tossed in the Water - Jonah" - *Splash*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Jonah
- Main Point: Jesus is the Word of God

July 17 - "Up Out of the Water - Jesus' Baptism" - *Splash*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Matthew 3, Luke 3 & John 1
- Main Point: Jesus is the Lamb of God

July 24 - "The Living Water" - *Splash*

- Main Point: Jesus gives Living Water

AUGUST 2022

August 7 - "Be Intentional" - *Be an Influencer*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Acts 9
- Main Point: To be an influential person, you have to be intentional with your actions and be aware of your actions and how they affect others. You have a purpose, and you won't let anything get in the way of it.

August 14 - "Be Selfless" - *Be an Influencer*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: David & Jonathan/ 1 Samuel 20
- Main Point: To be an effective influencer, you have to have people who will follow you. In order to be a good leader, you have to be willing to listen to others and speak thoughtfully to them.

August 21 - "Be Trustworthy" - *Be an Influencer*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Joshua 24
- Main Point: In order to influence others, they have to trust what you are saying. They have to know that you keep your word and what you speak is the truth.



August 28 - "Be Inspirational" - *Be an Influencer*

- Teaching Passage/ Story: the life of Jesus
- Main Point: Being an inspiration is no easy task. You have to encourage others to do what is right and believe in the unbelievable. This comes from developing relationships, proving your trustworthiness, and allowing others to speak.

- Teaching Passage/ Story: Psalm 90
- Main Point: God is eternal

- Key Point: walking in faith means relying on and trusting in God when we don't understand our circumstances.

THROUGH THE BIBLE ONE BOOK AT A TIME

Age group: Elementary – K-6/ ages 5-11

“The B-I-B-L-E: Through the Bible One Book at a Time” is a complete curriculum resource for churches who desire to see their children grow in Bible literacy. The point of these materials is to deepen children’s understanding of the big picture of the Bible. By the end of the year, every student in the group should be able to quote the books of the Bible from memory (using hand motions as prompts if necessary) and tell something about each book of the Bible and how it points to the cross.

The 5 lessons included in this bundle offer a glimpse into the curriculum (along with the Exodus sample lesson available on the site). These lessons help you to show the kids in your church that the Bible is one big story about Jesus and help them to develop an understanding of the layout of the Bible.

These lessons are also perfect to fill in other times in the year when you need review or a stand-alone lesson as they don't build on each other as many other series do.



Age group: Elementary – K-6/ ages 5-11

“God is Love” is a stand-alone Sunday School Lesson on the love of God displayed through Jesus. This lesson is designed to help kids (and teachers) remember that God is love and that He ultimately showed His love through Jesus’ death in our place. This is the perfect lesson for Valentine’s Day, allowing you to dive deep into the love of God.

Text – John 3:1-21

The main point – Jesus is the Salvation of the world

The key verse for this lesson is John 3:17 –

“For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him.”

8 Lessons for Children

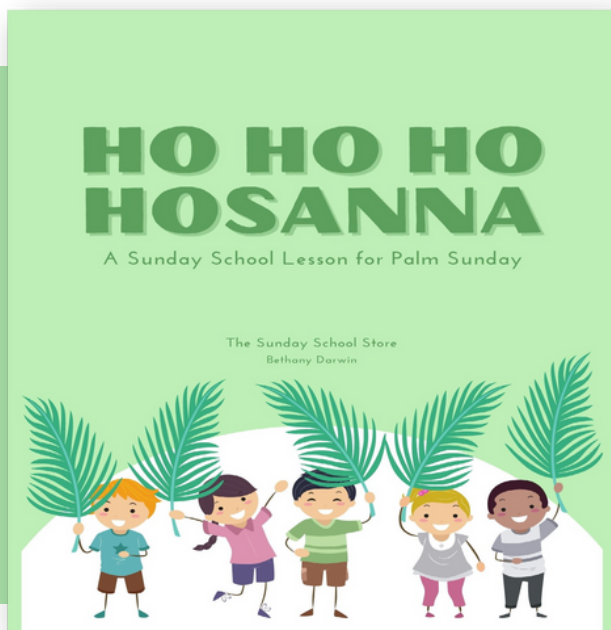


Age group: Elementary – K-6/ ages 5-11

The story of God making the world is the starting point for learning about God. His power and goodness are shown in his work of creating the world in seven days.

This expanded and updated curriculum will introduce children to the awesome details of how God made the world.

Also included with this curriculum are several sets of coloring pages/worksheets to supplement the teaching in the lessons.



Age group: Elementary – K-6/ ages 5-11

“Ho Ho Ho Hosanna” is a 1-week stand-alone lesson focusing on the worship of Jesus during His final days on earth – both in being anointed by Mary, and the crowds rejoicing at His entry into Jerusalem. In this lesson, students will see Jesus as the Triumphant and Forever King and will be given the opportunity to worship Him. They will also learn that worship is focusing 100% on God and giving all glory to Him alone. It’s all about Him and not about us.



Age group: Elementary – K-6/ ages 5-11

"Jesus is Alive Forever" is an excerpt from the series "Why Easter?" This series is designed to teach kids the hope of Christ's resurrection. "Why Easter?" is a 5 lesson series on the final days of Jesus' earthly ministry. Through familiar Bible stories, children will see various aspects of the work Jesus did on the cross on the behalf of His people and understand more the importance of Easter.

The full 5-week series follows this outline:

1. Jesus is the Servant King – John 13:1-16
2. Jesus is the Passover Lamb – Matthew 26:26-29
3. Jesus is Our Substitute – Mark 14:32-50
4. Jesus is the Perfect Sacrifice – Mark 14, John 18 & Luke 22
5. Jesus is Alive Forever – John 20



Age group: Elementary – 1-6/ ages 6-12

“Challenges” are wildly popular on YouTube and social media. This series captures some of the family-friendly fun to teach kids about following Jesus.

Children will love these game-based lessons that points them back to the ultimate challenge – deciding to follow Jesus and live a life devoted to God. This curriculum is flexible enough to handle a wide range of age groups in even the smallest Sunday school. We have included “more than enough” with each lesson to help you adapt to every teaching situation. Use what you can to teach the main idea, even if your class time does not allow for all activities.



Age group: Elementary – K-6/ ages 5-11

“Splash” is a 7-week lesson series that takes kids on a wet & wild journey through the Bible while pointing to Jesus as the Living Water. Kids will experience familiar stories like Noah, Jonah, Jesus’ baptism, and others in a new way as they consider God’s authority over the water and how each of these stories points to salvation through Christ alone. Ultimately, the goal of this series is for children to be confronted with the Living Water (Jesus) and their individual need for salvation.

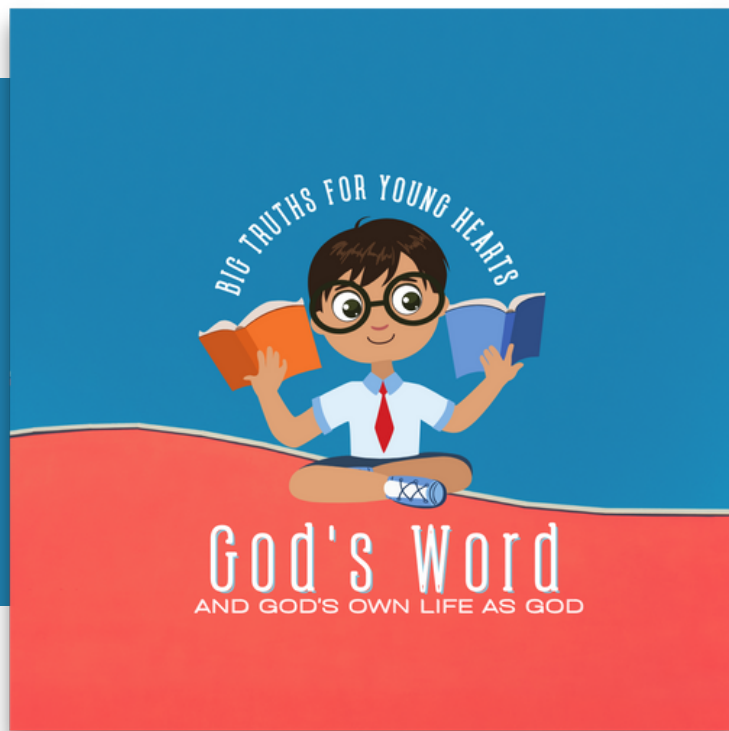
These lessons are written for children in grades K-5th and each lesson takes 60-90 minutes, making them perfect for Sunday School, Children’s Church, mid-week Bible study times, or even a summer camp with a water theme. Along with 7 full lessons, in “Splash” you will receive an outline for a water event with games, a suggested schedule, and a devotional that would be great to use as a kick-off or grand finale for the series.



Age group: Elementary – 1-6/ ages 6-12

“Influencers” are the new heroes in our culture. Kids dream of being popular on social media or even becoming professional YouTube creators or stars on TikTok. This series teaches children how to be a godly influence in real life by following God’s Word. Each lesson profiles a character in the Bible and shows how they influenced others by living out their faith. Children will be challenged to follow Jesus and let his light shine out to influence others.

This curriculum is flexible enough to handle a wide range of age groups in even the smallest Sunday school. We have included “more than enough” with each lesson to help you adapt to every teaching situation. Use what you can to teach the main idea, even if your class time does not allow for all activities.



Age group: Elementary – 1-6/ ages 6-12

This year-long curriculum series takes the concepts, or the BIG TRUTHS, presented in the book and provides teachers, parents, and churches with all the resources they need to proclaim those truths to the children in their lives.

The curriculum units follow the chapters in Dr. Ware's book. A list of the units in this series is found on page 6. The hope is that churches would teach straight through the materials, as in many ways the units do build on each other. But the units are also written in such a way that you could easily teach them as a stand-alone curriculum. A full scope and sequence of the materials is available to download from the Sunday School Store.

In these except lessons, we look deeper into the character of God. By taking the time to really get to know the God of the Bible, children will begin to see who they are in light of God's perfection. They lay a great foundation for the truths in the rest of the series and for other truths that you'll be teaching this year.



Age group: Elementary – K-6/ ages 5-12

Kids get bombarded with creepy, scary, and satanic imagery every October as the world celebrates FEAR. That's why we created this new 4-Week Curriculum titled "MORE FAITH / LESS FEAR." Now you can offer solid BIBLE answers to fears and help kids trust Jesus more during this crazy season. "More Faith / Less Fear" is unit two of our "Faith Over Fear" series designed to point your kids to God as their hope and refuge. In this Gospel-centered study, the meaning of faith is explored through the Hall of Faith in Hebrews 11.

Use this series as a continuation of Faith Over Fear or a stand-alone unit during the month of October. These lessons are perfect to combat the fears typical of childhood and show children that God is bigger than all their fears.
