



ABRAHAM AND SARAH

OBJECTIVE

Students will learn a brief overview of the story of Abraham & Sarah, from the Bible, Genesis 12-18, 21, and be able to answer discussion questions from the lesson.

MATERALS

- Bible
- Printed Teacher Book
- Printed copies of the mini book for students (prepare these ahead of time by cutting the page into 4 pages and stapling the book together)
- Crayons/Penci]

TEACHING TIME (5 minutes)

Ask students to join you as you open your Bible to Genesis. Explain to students that the story you are going to share with them comes right from God's Word in the Old Testament.

Show students the cover page of the Teacher Book. Ask them to tell you what they see on that picture. That should lead to the discussion of a man and a woman, with gray hair. Tell the students to listen as you read the story

Read the pages and show students the pictures as you go.

ACTIVITY (5 minutes)

Send students to their seats and distribute copies of their mini book. Direct students to write their name and color the pictures. When students are finished, move on to the discussion questions.


DISCUSSION (5 minutes)

- What did God ask Abraham to do? (God asked Abraham to move to a new country.)
- Where did God tell Abraham and Sarah to set up their tents? (God told them to live in the land of Canaan) ٧;
- Why did God tell Abraham to count the stars in the sky? (God knew that Abraham and Sarah wanted children so he told them that they would have as many children as there were stars in the sky.) ω,
- Did Abraham believe what God promised him? (Yes, Abraham believed God.) 4.
- Why did God call Abraham righteous and what does that mean? (God said Abraham was righteous because he oelieved what God told him. That meant that Abraham loved and obeyed God.) പ്
- How old were Abraham and Sarah when God blessed them with a baby boy? (Abraham was 100 and Sarah was 99 years old when God gave them a baby.) છ
- What did they name the baby? (They named their son Isaac.) ~ ∞
- What does the word faithfulness mean? (Faithfulness means that someone is true to their word and that they can be trusted to do what they say.)
- Did God keep his promise to Abraham and Sarah? (Yes, God ALWAYS keeps his promises!)
