
Armor of God Lap Book


Read Ephesians 6:10-20 with your students before completing this lap book.



Students cut and color the soldier. Glue half of the soldier on each half of the lap book cover. Glue the words, "Armor of God," at the top.







Opened Flaps






Students will cut on the dashed line. Then they will fold on the solid black line. Fill in the blanks. Glue onto the left and right flaps.







