



OBJECTIVE

Students will learn about how God saved Daniel from the lions from Daniel 6. They will also be able to answer discussion questions from the lesson.

MATERALS

- Bible
- Printed Teacher Book
- Printed copies of the mini book for students (prepare these ahead of time by cutting the page into 4 pages and stapling the book together)
- Crayons/Pencil

TEACHING TIME (5 minutes)

Daniel. Explain to students that they are going to learn about how God saved Daniel from Ask students to join you as you open your Bible to the Old Testament, to the book of being eaten by lions.

Show students the cover page of the Teacher Book. Ask them to tell you what they see in the picture. Tell the students to listen as you read the story.

Read the pages and show students the pictures as you go.

ACTIVITY (5 minutes)

Send students to their seats and distribute copies of their mini book. Direct students to write their name and color the pictures. When students are finished, move on to the discussion questions.

DISCUSSION (5 minutes)


- Who was the King of Babylon in our story? (The King of Babylon was King Darius.)
- Why did King Darius choose Daniel to be his helper? (The King chose Daniel because he was trustworthy and wise.)
- What did the new law say and what was the punishment for breaking it? (The new law said that people could only pray to the king. If anyone broke the law, they would be thrown into a lions den.) ကံ
- Did Daniel obey the law? Why or why not? (Daniel did not obey the law because he knew it was wrong to pray to someone besides God.) せ
- What happened when Daniel was thrown into the lion's den? (God saved Daniel by sending an angel to shut the mouths of the lions.) ഗ്
