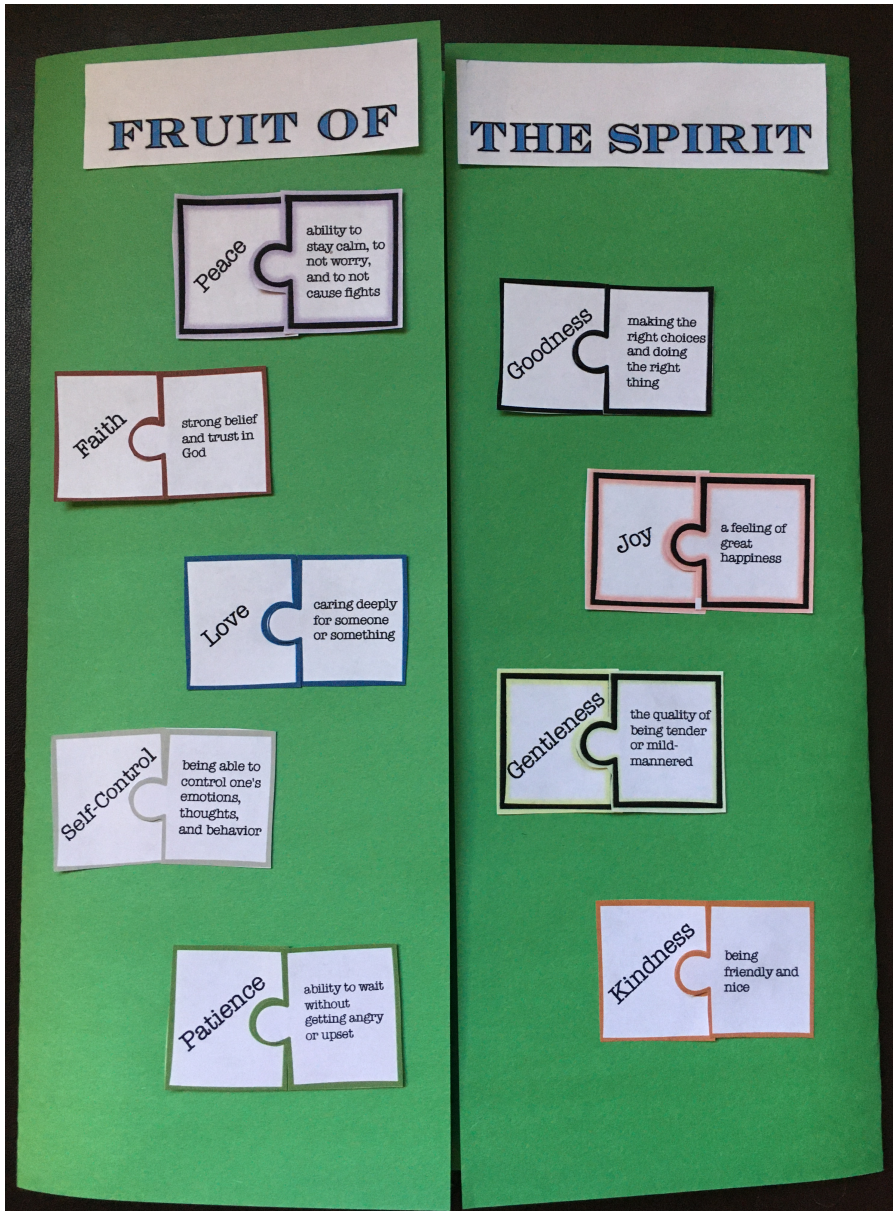


Fruit of the Spirit Lapbook

Read Galatians 5:22-23 with your students before completing this lapbook.

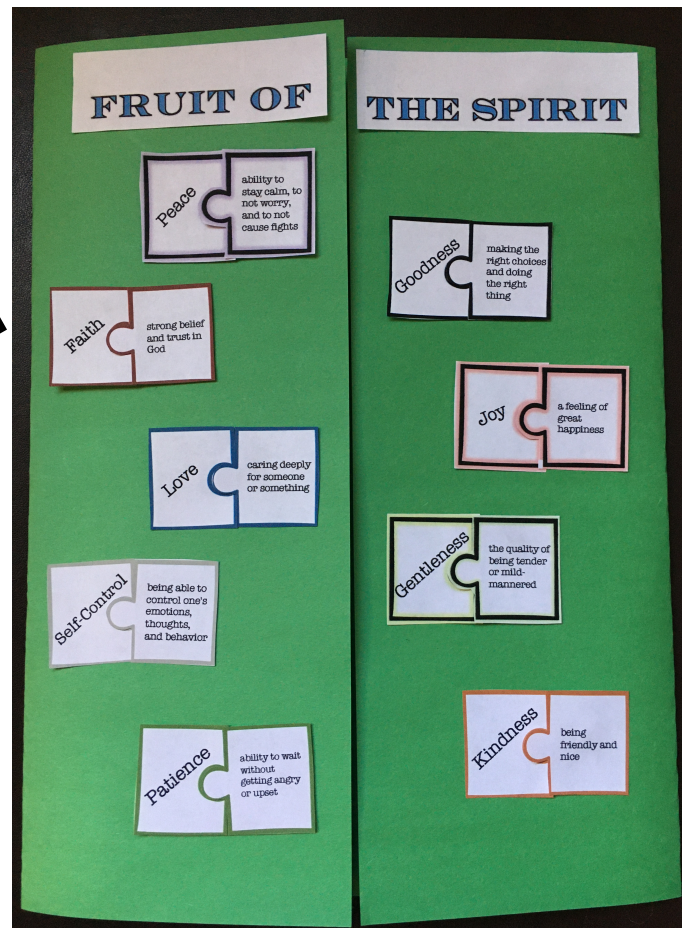
Print pages 6-15 of this hand out as double sided. Use the pictures below to easily assemble your Fruit of the Spirit lapbook. Each student will need a large piece of construction paper folded in thirds with the flaps meeting in the middle.



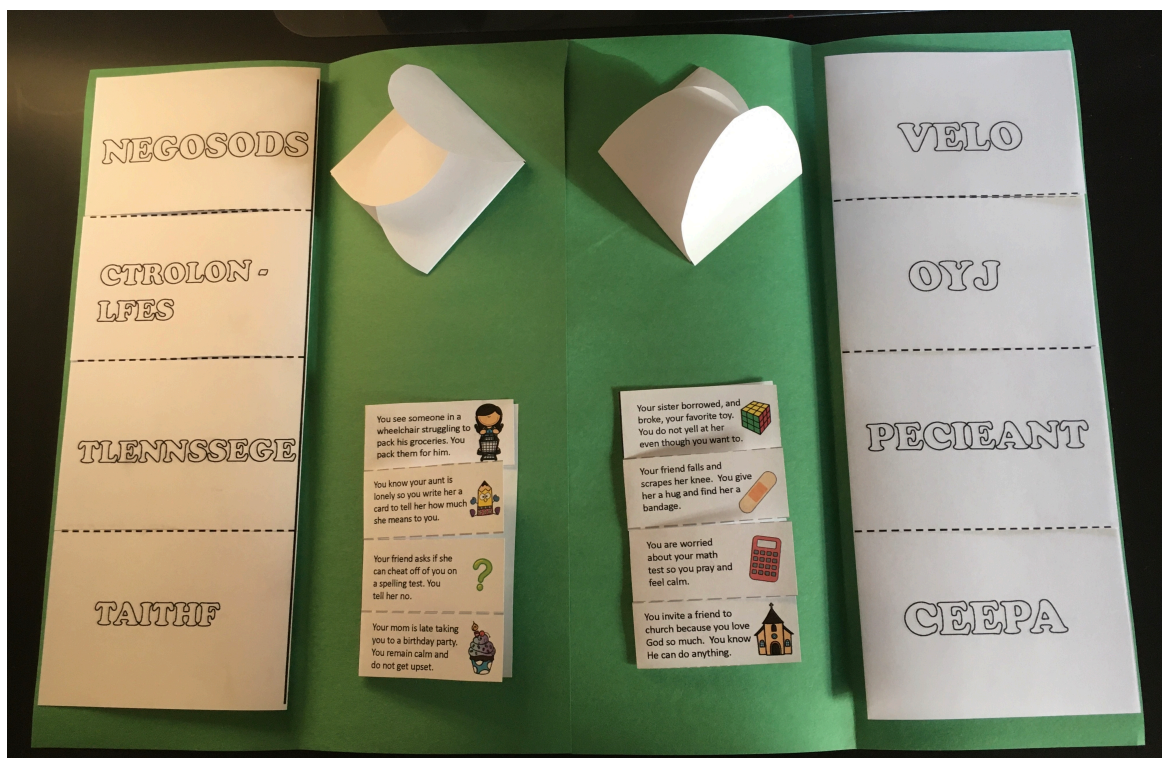

Completed Example

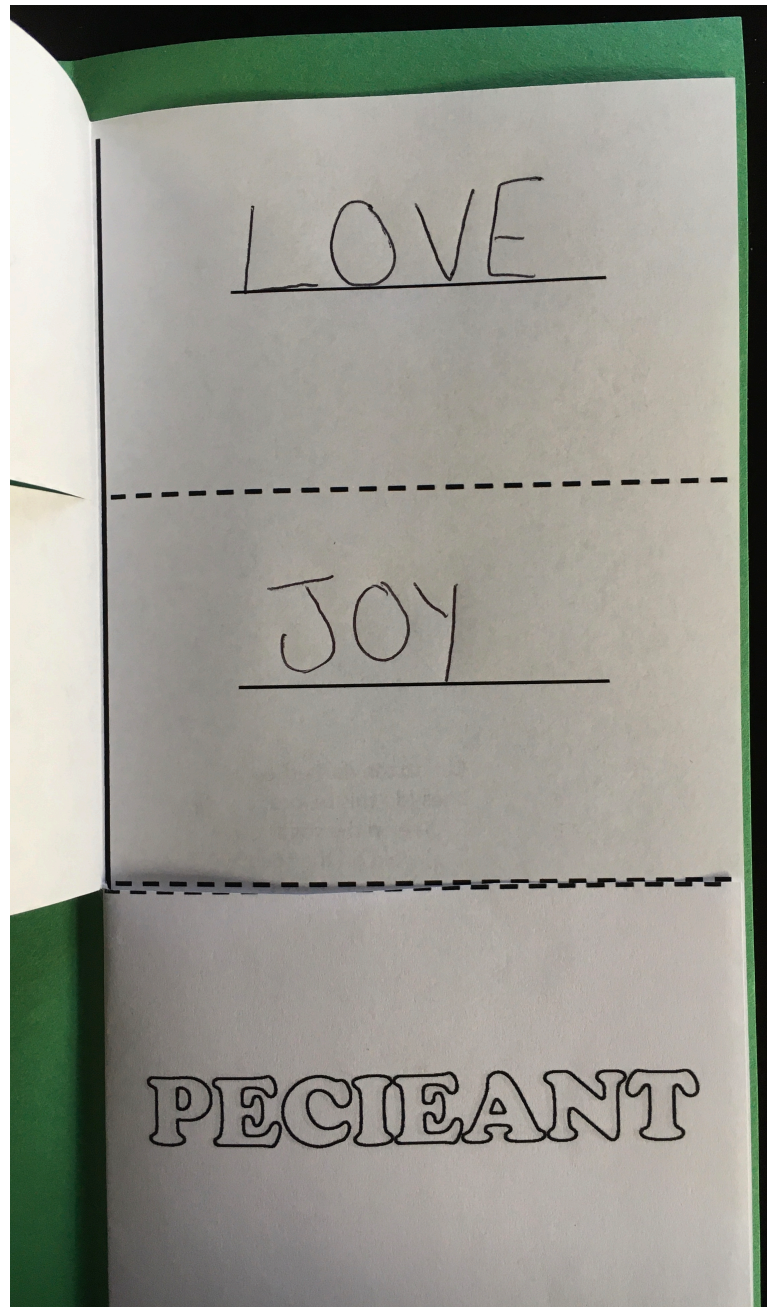
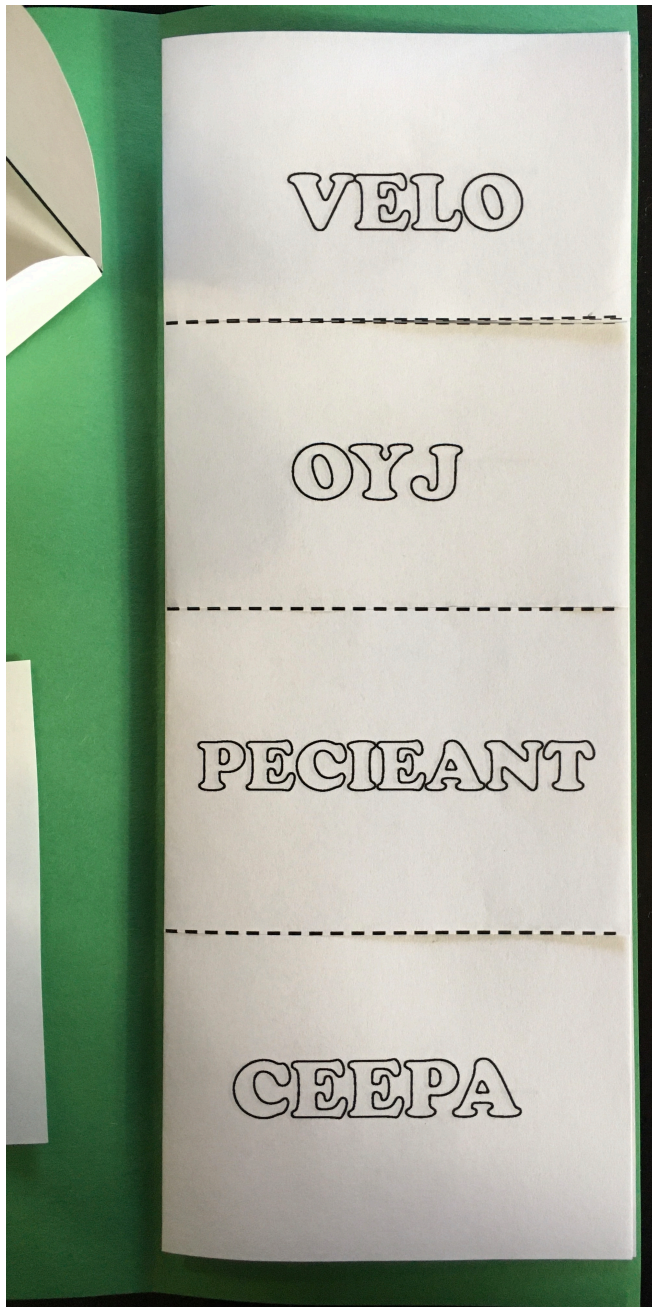

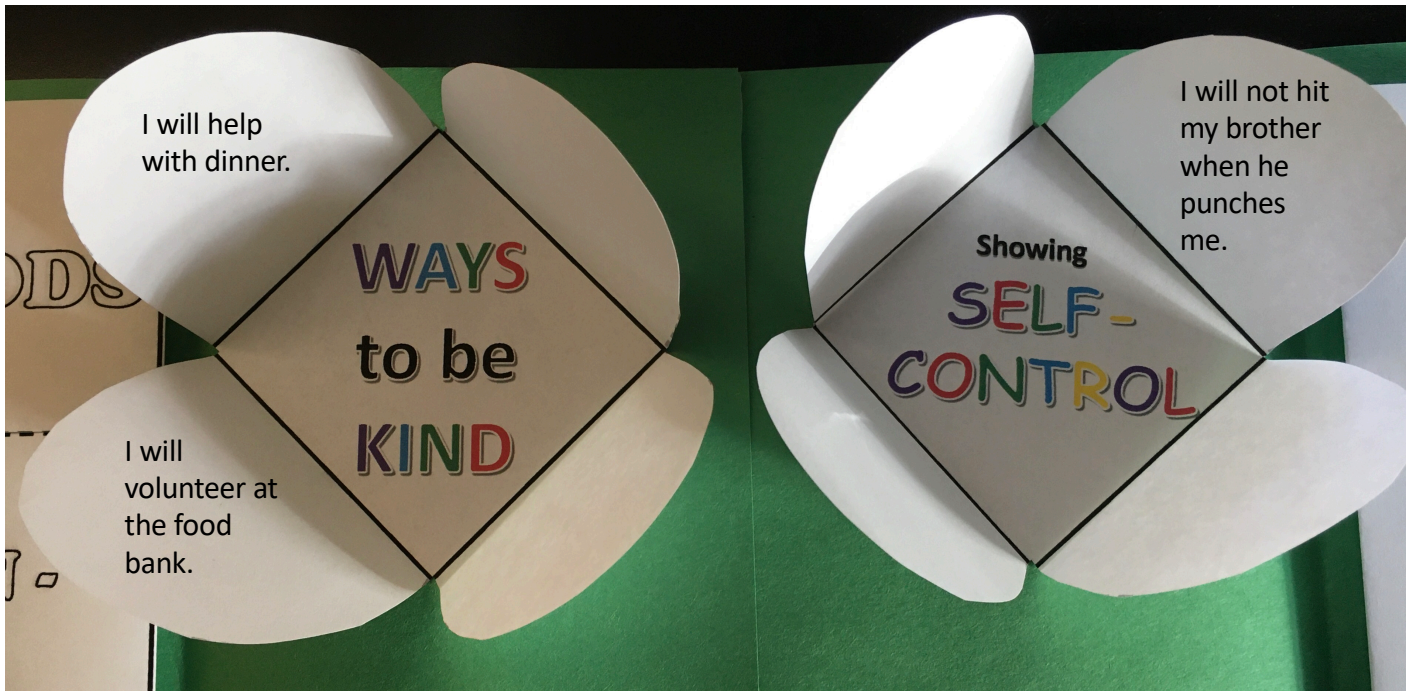


Opened Flaps

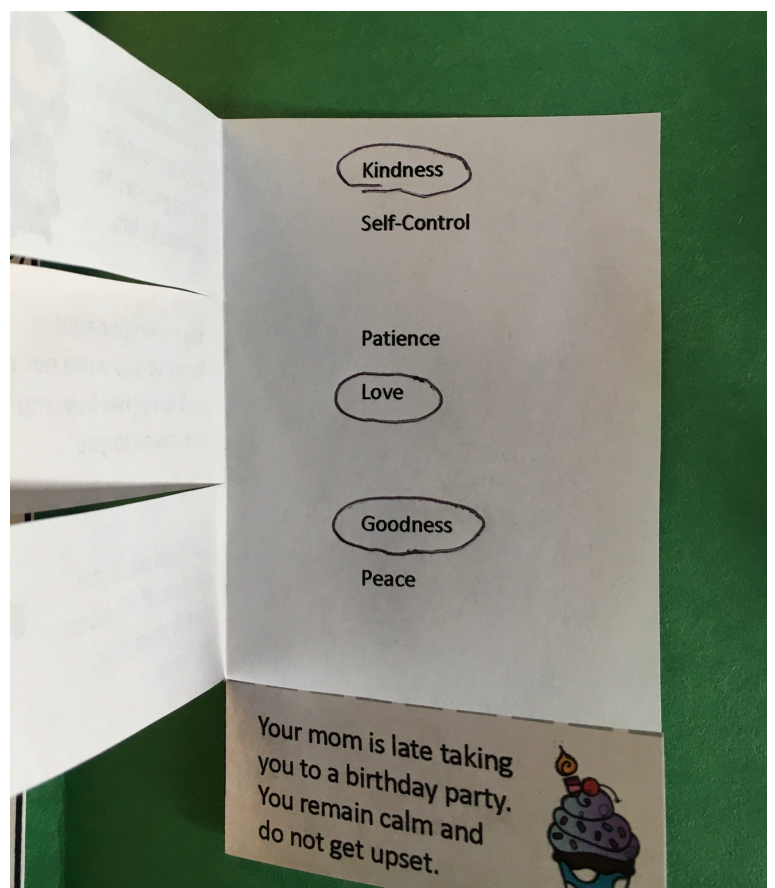
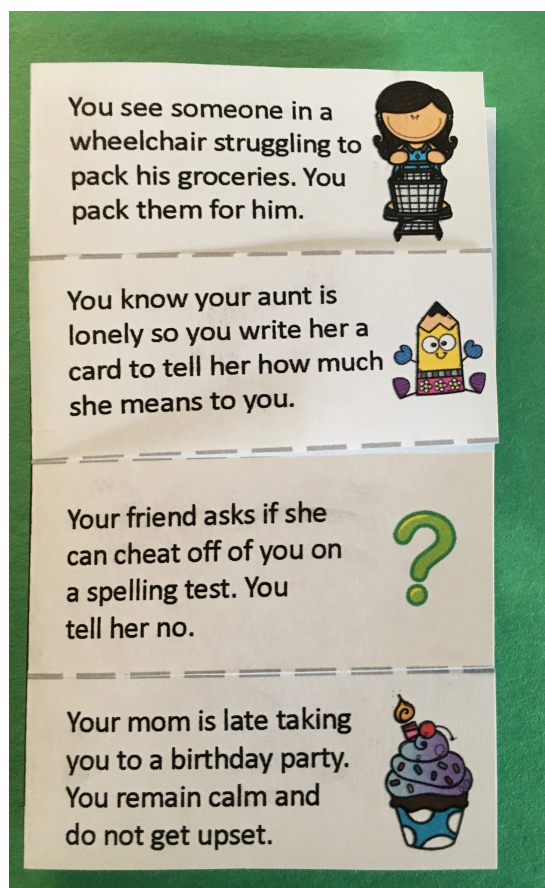


Students will unscramble the letters to reveal a fruit of the spirit found in Galatians 5:22-23.

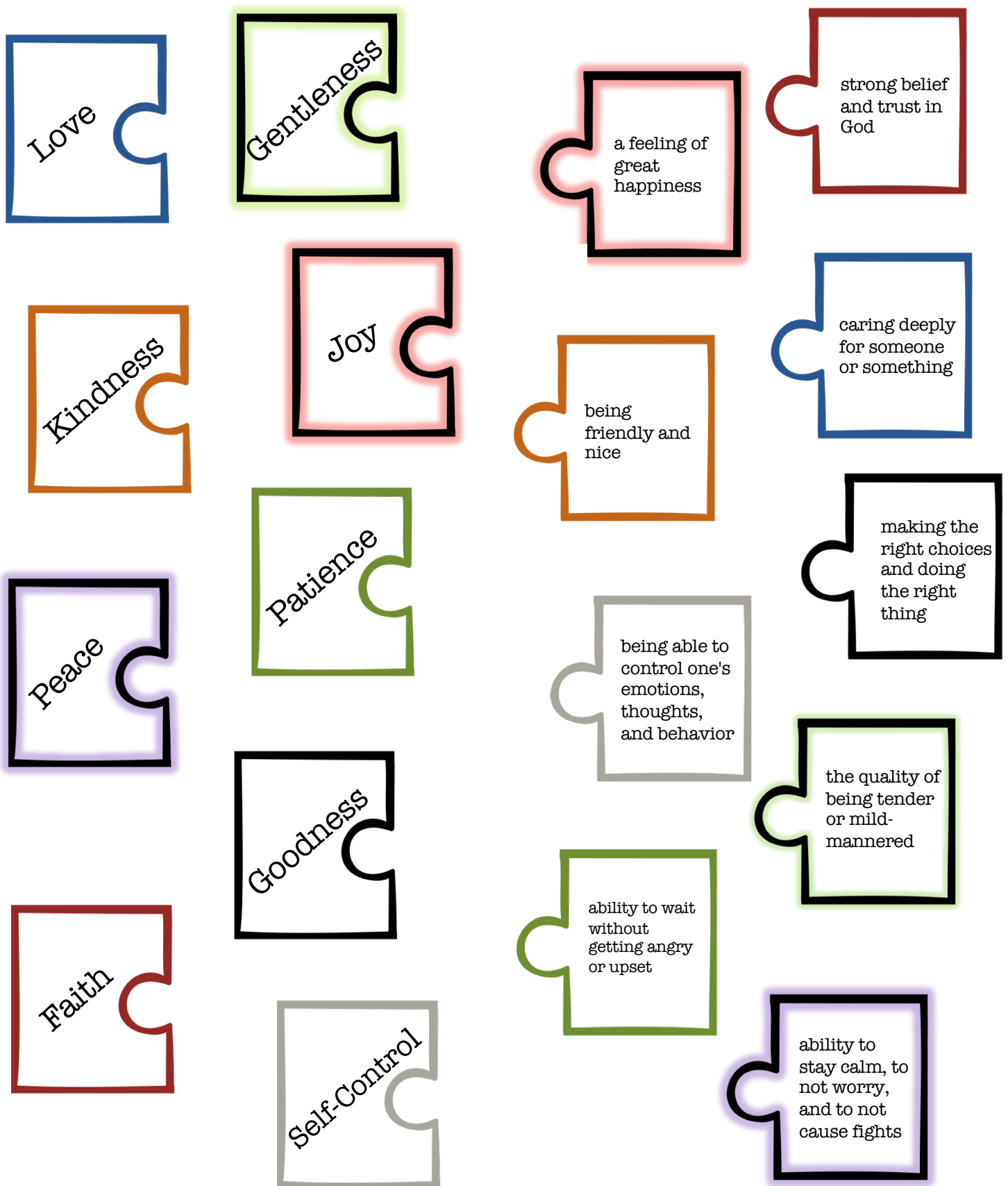
Middle

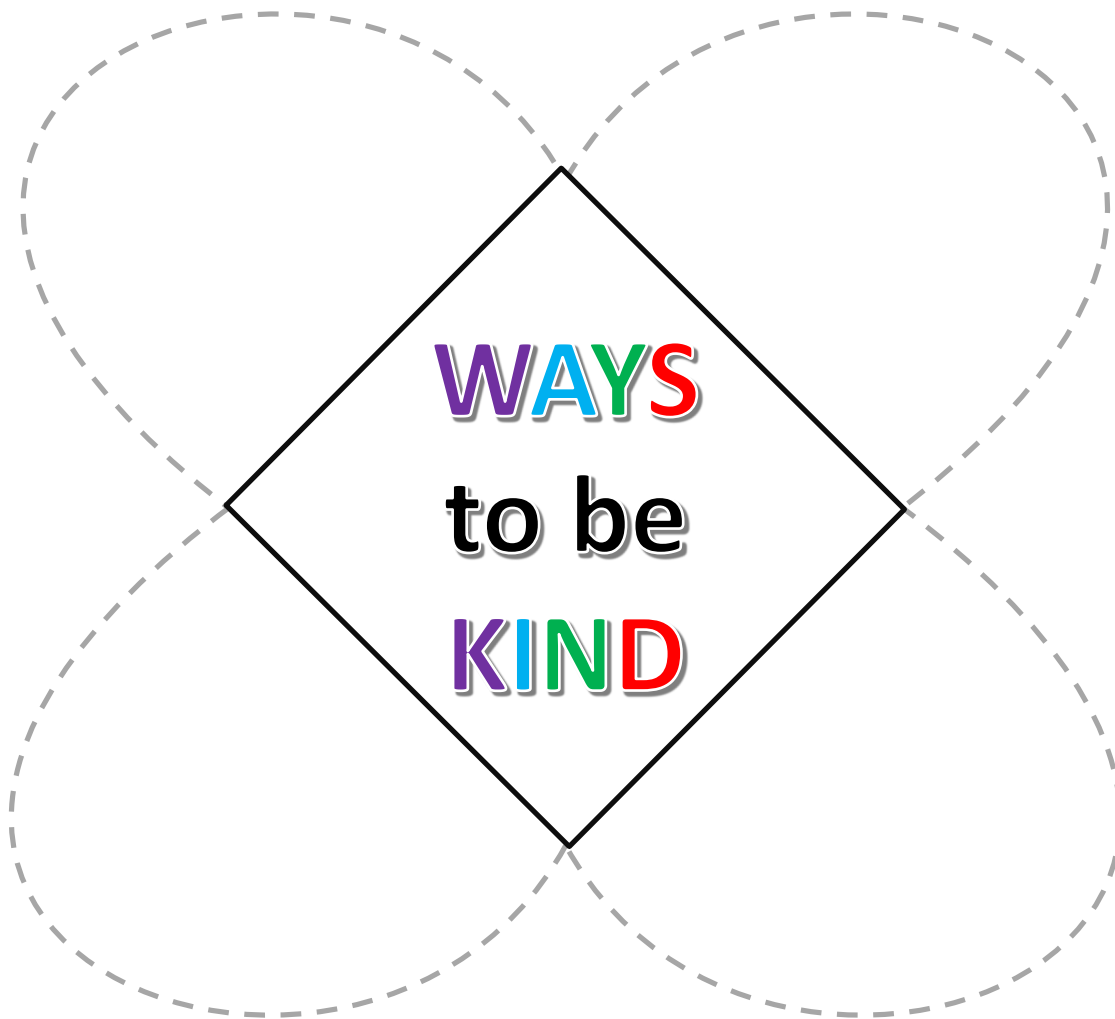

Cut on the dashed lines. Fold on the solid line. Glue to the middle of your lapbook. Under the opened flaps, circle which fruit of the spirit is being demonstrated.

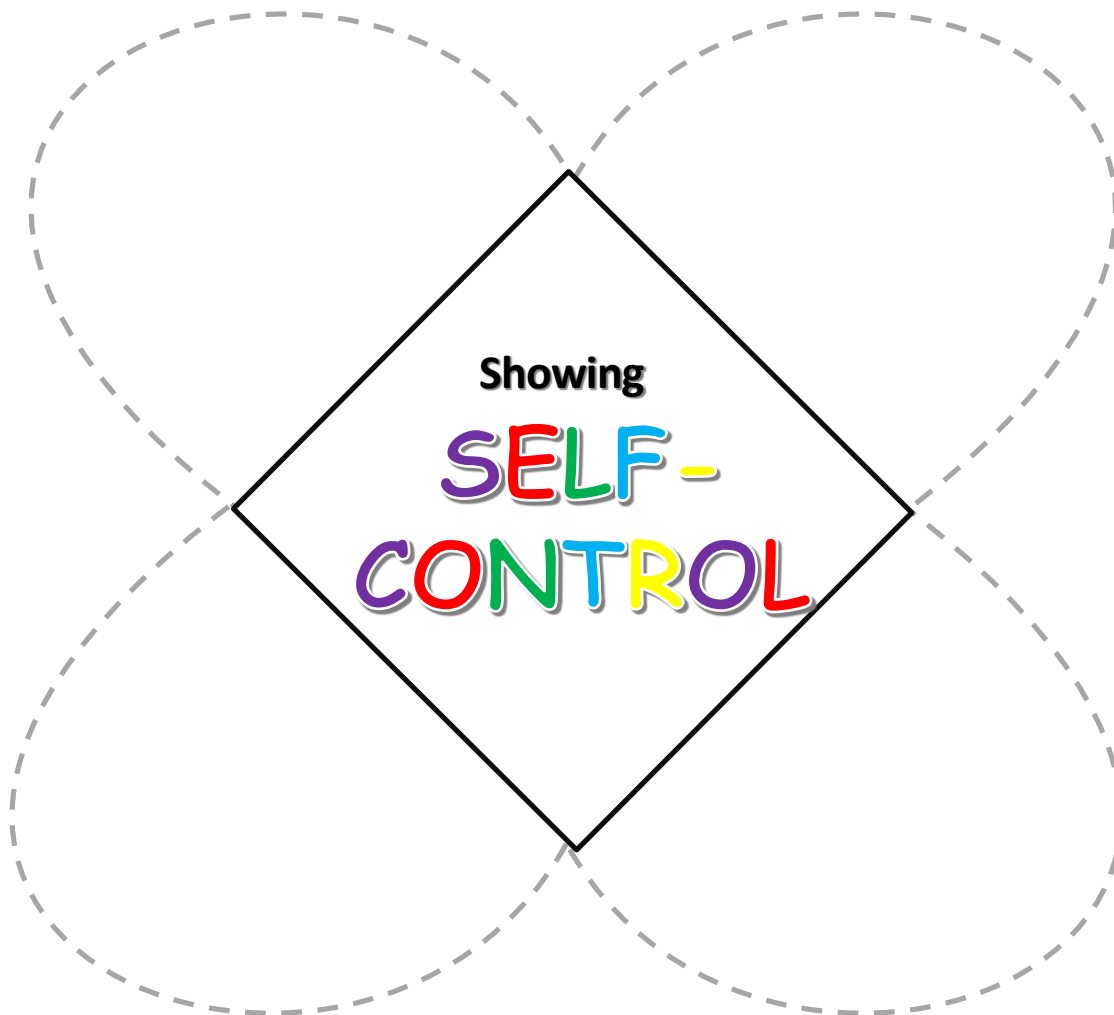

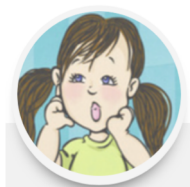
