# Mini Lesson Plan MARY & JOSEPH

## OBJECTIVE

Students will learn the story of Mary & Joseph, from the Bible, Matthew 118-25, Luke 1.26-38, 2.1-7, and be able to answer discussion questions from the lesson

## MATERALS

- Bible
- Printed Teacher Book
- Printed copies of the mini book for students (prepare these ahead of time by cutting the page into 4 pages and stapling the book together)
- Crayons/Pencils

# TEACHING TIME (5 minutes)

Ask students to join you as you open your Bible to Luke I (or one of the other references listed above). Explain to students that the story you are going to share with them comes right from God's Word Show students the cover page of the Teacher Book. Ask them to tell you what they see on that picture. That should lead to the discussion of Mary and Joseph. Tell the students that this special man and woman were chosen by God to be a part of his plan. Tell the students to listen as you read the story

Read the pages and show students the pictures as you go.

## ACTIVITY (5 minutes)

Send students to their seats and distribute copies of their mini book. Direct students to write their name and color the pictures. When students are finished, move on to the

# DISCUSSION (5 minutes)

- Who did God send to visit Mary & Joseph? (An Angel)
- What was the message that God had the angel share with Mary & Joseph? (They were going to have a baby boy, Jesus, who was the Son of God.)
- Where did Mary & Joseph travel to? (Bethlehem) Ω.
- Where was the baby born? (He was born in a dirty stable.) 4.
- Why was the birth of this baby so special? (Jesus was God's gift to us. He is the rescuer, the Messiah.)

Total Time for Lesson - 15 minutes


