

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Bible Story Mini Lesson
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## OBJECTIVE

Students will learn the story of The Ten Plagues, from the Bible, Exodus 7-12, and be able to answer discussion questions from the lesson.

## MATERALS

- Printed Teacher Book
- Printed copies of the mini book for students (prepare these ahead of time by cutting the page into 4 pages and stapling the book together)
- **Crayons/Pencils**

# TEACHING TIME (5 minutes)

Ask students to join you as you open your Bible to Exodus 7-12. Explain to students that the story you are going to share with them comes right from God's Word. Show students the cover page of the Teacher Book. Ask them to tell you what they see on that picture and engage in discussion. Tell the students to listen as you read the story.

Read the pages and show students the pictures as you go.


## ACTIVITY (5 minutes)


Send students to their seats and distribute copies of their mini book. Direct students to write their name and color the pictures. When students are finished, move on to the discussion questions.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> plague God sent to punish Pharaoh was...frogs! Frogs were everywhere! Pharaoh wanted the frogs gone, so he said the people could go. But as soon as God sent the frogs away, Pharaoh changed his mind.

Because Pharaoh would not free the Israelites, God sent the 3rd plague. Lice covered the Egyptians. Bugs were in their hair, on their skin and made them itch terribly.

God sent locusts, the 8th plague, to cover the ground and eat all the crops.







Moses told Pharaoh that if he did not free God's people, the first-born child of every Egyptian family would die. Pharaoh's heart was hardened toward God. He was angry and refused to let God's people go.

Moses went back to the Israelites, told them to pack, and be ready to leave. That night, a loud cry was heard throughout Egypt. Pharaoh's firstborn son, and all the other firstborn children of Egypt, had died.









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
