



Mini Lesson Flan

THE LAST SUPPER

OBJECTIVE

Students will learn the story of the Last Supper, from the Gospel accounts in Matthew 26, Mark 14, Luke 22, and John 13, and be able to answer discussion questions from the lesson. This lesson includes the preparation for the Passover meal, Jesus telling the disciples that Judas would betray him, and the final teachings Jesus gave his

MATERAIS

- Bible
- Printed Teacher Book
- Printed copies of the mini book for students (prepare these ahead of time by cutting the page into 4 pages and stapling the book together)
- Crayons/Pencils

TEACHING TIME (5 minutes)

Ask students to join you as you open your Bible to the New Testament. Explain to students that the story you are going to share with them comes right from God's Word.

Show students the cover page of the Teacher Book. Ask them to tell you what they see on that picture. Tell the students to listen as you read the story. Explain to your students that the lesson of the Last Supper tells about Jesus' last night on earth.

Read the pages and show students the pictures as you go.

ACTIVITY (5 minutes)

Send students to their seats and distribute copies of their mini book. Direct students to write their name and color the pictures. When students are finished, move on to the discussion questions.


DISCUSSION (5 minutes)

- Jesus told two of his disciples to find a man carrying something. What was it? (Jesus told them to find man carrying a pitcher.)
- Jesus told the 12 disciples that one of them would betray him that night. Who was it? (Judas would betray Jesus that night.) You may need to explain the word betray tell students that in this story, it meant that one of the men who claimed to be one of Jesus' best friends, was going to hand him over to the people who wanted to kill him. Betrayed means to be disloyal and unfaithful.
- How did the disciples feel about all the things Jesus was telling them? (The disciples were confused and Б.
- Jesus said that when he left, he would send a Comforter, the Holy Spirit. What would the Holy Spirit do? (The Holy Spirit would be with them and give them strength.) 4.


Optional — Extend the discussion - If your students are able to dig a little deeper, follow up with details of what the Passover signified (Exodus 12) was and why Jesus and his disciples were celebrating it. You can also take a few moments to explain the first, "Lord's Supper," with Jesus breaking the bread and sharing the wine Expand on the meaning of eating the bread (the breaking of his body) and drinking the wine (the shedding of his blood). Tell students that Christians all over the world still follow this tradition today, all because of what Jesus taught his disciples that night.


