



THE LEN COMMANDMENTS

Students will learn about the 10 Commandments, why they are important and what each one is. They will also be able to answer discussion questions from the lesson.

MATERALS

- Printed Teacher Book
- Printed copies of the mini book for students (prepare these ahead of time by cutting the page into 4 pages and stapling the book together)
- Crayons/Pencil

TEACHING TIME (5 minutes)

Ask students to join you as you open your Bible. Explain to students that they are going to learn about when God gave rules for the people to follow.

Show students the cover page of the Teacher Book. Ask them to tell you what they see in the picture. Explain to students that God wrote the rules he wanted his people to live by on stone tablets. Tell the students to listen as you

Read the pages and show students the pictures as you go.

ACTIVITY (5 minutes)

Send students to their seats and distribute copies of their mini book. Direct students to write their name and color the pictures. When students are finished, move on to the discussion questions.


DISCUSSION (5 minutes)

- Where did God give Moses the 10 Commandments? (God spoke to Moses on top of Mount Sinai and gave him the 10 Commandments there.)
- Why are the commands important for us today? (The 10 Commandments teach us how to honor God with our actions. We show God we love him by obeying his commands.)
- What is the $1^{
 m st}$ Commandment? (God should be the most important thing in your life.)
- What is the 2^{nd} Commandment? (Do not have any idols, Only worship God.)
- What is the $3^{
 m rd}$ Commandment? (Do not misuse the name of God.) δ,
- What is the 4th Commandment? (Remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy.) 6.
 - What is the 5th Commandment? (Honor your father and mother.)
- What is the 6th Commandment? (Do not kill.) ∞.
- What is the 7th Commandment? (Be loyal to your husband or wife.)
- What is the 8th Commandment? (Do not steal.) 0.
- What is the 9th Commandment? (Do not tell lies.)
- What is the 10th Commandment? (Do not want what others have.)
- Extend the discussion, Go back through each commandment and ask students what it means or to give an example of what it looks like to follow or obey that commandment.
