

SCRIPTURE READING

Matthew 28:18-20 - ¹⁸ And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

¹⁹Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

²⁰Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

Acts 8:26-28 - ²⁶And the angel of the Lord spake unto Philip, saying, Arise, and go toward the south unto the way that goeth down from Jerusalem unto Gaza, which is desert.

²⁷And he arose and went: and, behold, a man of Ethiopia, an eunuch of great authority under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, who had the charge of all her treasure, and had come to Jerusalem for to worship,

²⁸Was returning, and sitting in his chariot read Esaias the prophet.

Acts 8:34-36 - ³⁴And the eunuch answered Philip, and said, I pray thee, of whom speaketh the prophet this? of himself, or of some other man?

³⁵Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus.

³⁶And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized?

Acts 8:38 - ³⁸And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him.

Romans 6:1-6 - What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?

²God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

³Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?

⁴Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

⁵For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:

⁶Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

CANDIDATES INTERVIEW AND DECLARATION OF FAITH

Pastor: Do you know that you are God's child through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Savior?

Candidate: I do.

Pastor: Is it your earnest desire to follow Christ in death to self and to walk with Him in newness of life?

Candidate: It is.

Pastor: Do you hereby renounce, repudiate and reject the kingdom of darkness, Satan and all his works with all his pomp and pride?

Candidate: I do.

Baptism: The Pastor would position the folded handkerchief firmly over the candidate's nose and mouth making sure the candidate grasp the Pastor's wrist with both hands, and the Pastor places his left hand below the candidate's shoulders and say the following:

" ______ {name of the candidate}, upon your confession of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Savior, and by this step of obedience to Him in this ordinance, expressing your desire to follow Him in death to self and to walk with Him in newness of life, I baptize you in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen"
