MAKING YOUR LEADERSHIP EFFECTIVE

I Chronicles 28:11-21.

LEADERS AS A MANAGER: The leader as a manager must be seen or operate within the context of the Vision of the Ministry/Church. There is need for accountability to God, to the other leaders and the members, therefore, consultation with the Head-ship of the church before important decisions are made is advisable.

UNDERSTAND CLEARLY 2 Timothy 2:4-7

1. **The task** – what is the job to be done? How to do it?
 2. **The workers** - who can do the job? Are they qualified and prepared?
 3. **The resources** – what resources are available? Where can we get more?
- These things must be put into consideration as a good manager in God's work.

PLAN CAREFULLY AND COMPREHENSIVELY

1. Prepare the people, share out the vision constantly.
2. Outline the steps towards fulfilling the vision.
3. Delegate tasks according to the gifts and ability of each person, particularly among those that have demonstrated their confidence in your leadership.
4. Tell them why; show them how; do it with them; get them started (*doing things by themselves*).
5. Prepare and organise resources and materials appropriate for each task.
6. Build a close relationship with members of your team or group.
7. Review and evaluate the outcome to see what has to be adjusted.
